



WAUSAU WHITEWATER

Since 1974 Wausau Whitewater Park has been the host of multiple National, North American, World Cup and World Championship events, and continues to be a venue for both public recreational releases and competition each year.

Wausau Whitewater course is 1/3 mile in length with more than 11 whitewater features for paddlers of all skill levels from beginner to advanced. The bottom of the course features are easier with more advanced features upstream. Sidewalks, seating and boater access are all along the rivers edge throughout the 1/3 mile course in the heart of downtown Wausau, WI. Wausau Whitewater's hosting of local, regional, national and world events over time has contributed millions of dollars of economic impact to the greater Wausau area, and much more than what dollars can ever measure. Every time the water is turned on for a public Rec Release weekend in summer, more than 200 boaters from multiple states come to Wausau. Totaling thousands of boaters & families from across the country and world that have come to Wausau Rec Releases each summer to park and play the whitewater features for all skill levels.

Wausau Whitewater also hosts annual events like Team River Runners for disabled Vets and their families, as well as offering Learn To Kayak programs for all ages of the community each year. A venue that hosts Olympic paddlers and World Champions also provides community recreation and a training ground for rising stars.

Wausau Whitewater is also a place for training our fire depts in swift water rescue and our Boy Scouts in life experiences. With an improved world class course and whitewater features the best paddlers in the world come for, and improved seating and access to Whitewater Parks river edge that spectators, pedestrians, fisherman, paddlers and the community continue to enjoy, join us this year at Wausau Whitewater Park!
